On Monday, June 2, 2025, District Lodge 19 will be hosting its 10th Annual Guide Dogs of America Southeast Championship Charity Golf Tournament at the Chattanooga Golf & Country Club (CGCC) in Chattanooga, TN. Founded in 1896, the Chattanooga Golf & Country Club encompasses acres of waterfront property on the Tennessee River. It boasts a championship 18-hole golf course, a swim and tennis center, and a 50,000-square-foot clubhouse with dining rooms for its members, as well as a large banquet facility.

Our 9th annual tournament in 2024 raised over \$70,000 for the Guide Dogs of America. This great organization is a non-profit that relies solely upon voluntary donations. Every sponsor, golfer, and volunteer gave back independence and changed the lives of men and women who are visually impaired.

Again, this year, there will be a Hole in One contest with two (2) chances for a winner. The first individual to make a hole-in-one on the Par 3 Ninth Hole will win a cash prize of \$10,000; the first to make a hole-in-one on the Par 3 Eighteenth Hole will win a Ford Vehicle. Many great prizes will also be given away.
